### **Student Application**

#### **The King's University Announces \$1500 Scholarships to be awarded to 3 female and 3 male student-athletes**

The King's University is offering 3 female and 3 male \$1500 scholarships in recognition of: their leadership and commitment to their community; demonstration of wellness principles as part of a healthy and balanced lifestyle; and proven leadership abilities as a high performance athlete.

Scholarships are available to both new and returning students-athletes, who have been promised a position on an ACAC team representing The King's University for the 2018-19 season. Applicants can only apply for one of the three scholarships being offered.

To be eligible, applicants must meet the criteria outlined below for each scholarship, and complete the application form. Applicants must also be an accepted student at King's and be registered for a minimum of 12 credits per term for the 2018-19 academic year. The scholarship will be awarded in 2018-19, with half of it credited each term.

***The application deadline is July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.***

#### ***Scholarship Criteria***

##### ***The Edmonton Oilers Community Foundation Service Award***

Number of Awards: 2 (1 male and 1 female)

Award Value: \$1,500 each

- *Students must be a member of a recognized athletics team at King's.*
- *Incoming high school students should have an average of 70% or higher on entrance marks.*
- *Returning students should have a minimum grade point average of 2.0 in their previous year of post-secondary study.*
- *Financial need*
- *References must be provided (3)*
- *Demonstrate leadership abilities and a high level of proficiency in their sport.*
- *Possess personal qualities such as dedication, commitment and strength of character.*
- *Preference will be given to students who are committed to 5-10 hours/week of volunteer coaching a high school/club team.*
