The Faculty of Education at The King's University is seeking a sessional instructor in Education for the High School English Language Arts portion for the following EDUC 430 course in the Winter Term of the 2025 academic year. This course contains six class sessions starting on January 7 and will end by January 28.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

EDUC 430: Curriculum and Instruction in Secondary English Language Arts, Social Studies, Physical Education and Fine Arts II

This class is for students in the secondary program who have a teachable in one of the listed areas. The candidate will co-teach this class along with a faculty member who is responsible for the Social Studies portion. This course focuses on teaching of English language arts, social studies, and the various non-core subjects at the Senior High level (grades 10-12). The Alberta programs of study are studied, and pre-service teachers discern the learning strategies, assessment theories and practices, and instructional management issues appropriate for Senior High students. Pre-service teachers are encouraged to be intentional about the strategies they use and reflective about their philosophy of education, view of human nature, and assumptions they employ.
