A non-refundable \$500 admission deposit is due after initial admission.

A \$5,000 tuition deposit is due before registration. Students may not enroll in classes until it has been paid.

A \$500 deposit is due with residence application.

Scholarships & Student Finance

Students are automatically awarded scholarships based on the average grade of their highest 4 standard courses:

90-100%	\$3,000
80-89%	\$2,000

A transfer scholarship of \$1,500 is available to students transferring from another institution with a CGPA of 3.50-4.00.

International students qualify for scholarships! Check the description of each scholarship to see if the award is limited to Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents — if not, you are eligible.
